

ELECTRONIC JOURNAL

- Scholar serial publication
- Computerized / digital / electronic form
 - Full form, not just abstract
 - With or without printed form
- Distributed over the internet / online (remote access electronic resource; www) or other electronic media (CD-ROM, DVD-ROM)


ELECTRONIC JOURNAL [EXTENSION]

- A way of <u>electronically documenting learning and storing information</u> for the purposes of reflection. For example, **blogs** can be developed and maintained as e-Iearning journals, which should be chronologically ordered and, where appropriate, include links to evidence of learning. 

ELECTRONIC JOURNAL [1]

- o A publication, often scholarly, that is made accessible in a computerized format and distributed over the Internet. ... ublib.buffalo.edu/libraries/help/glossarv.html
- A learned journal, but not necessarily refereed, on the Internet. Electronic journals offer reduced time to publication, allow hyperlinking to other documents, and, in some cases, are enhanced by multi-media materials.

ELECTRONIC JOURNAL [2]

- An electronic journal is a serial publication in digital format. The Boole Library subscribes to the online version of a large number of journals. Where appropriate, the Catalogue entry will provide a Hyperlink to the e-version, where the full text of an article may available. See also Moving Wall. booleweb.ucc.ie/info/services/glossary.htm
- A online publication that is organized like a traditional printed journal, either an online version of a printed journal or a journal that has only an online existence.

ELECTRONIC JOURNAL [3]

- o a journal whose issues are <u>online</u> just like the print version, but online www.lib.jmu.edu/gold/documents/glossary.doc
- similar to a traditional journal but published only in electronic form - on a CD-ROM or the World Wide Web.

• the version of a journal appearing on the web; sometimes this is identical to the <u>printed</u> version, sometimes it will contain additional material or will include updates, and sometimes the web version is the sole version

ELECTRONIC JOURNAL [4]

- A journal that is available in its full form online. JSTOR is a database that contains electronic journals. It allows you to search for journal articles by keyword, or actually browse through each volume.

- A remote-access electronic resource which contains information issued sequentially with a numeric or chronological designation, intended to continue indefinitely. It may be a reproduction of a printed journal or a wholly on-line publication. www.lib.unc.edu/cat/localdocs/gradman/glossary.html
